

The Call For Entrepreneurship initiative focuses on financing tech-based projects which have global potential





- ICT, Electronics & WEB (Information and Communications Technology, Electronics and Social Web concepts);
- Life Sciences (Biotechnology, new technologies, products and services for medical assistance, monitoring and alert, devices and equipment);
- Endogenous Resources (Energy, Agri-food sectors, forest industry and ocean industry), Nanotechnology and Materials;
- Travel & Leisure Tech (Innovative support or services and/or products complementary to the traditional tourism offer).

The Call For Entrepreneurship focuses on financing projects in the following stages of their life cycle



Stage of the Projects

- Pre-Seed stage projects: should have a working prototype completed, that allows us to validate the practical application of the technology and/or business idea, and should have potential customers with a confirmed interest, even if the company has not yet made any sales.
- Seed stage projects: should have some customers using its products, and be seeking funding to expand operations.
- Venture stage projects (Startup and Growth): should have an established product range and client base and be looking for incremental capital to expand into new geographies or product ranges.
